

CHAPTER P 3 PROCLAMATION POLICY

1. The procedural requirements in this Policy are intended to guide the Municipality with the making and/or reading of proclamations and the displaying of any symbols on Town property.
2. In this policy, unless the context otherwise requires,
 - (i) “Council meeting” means any meeting of the Council for the Town of Montague duly called to order.
 - (ii) “Proclamation or declaration” means any statement made, or requested to be made, in favour or against any recognized organization, time, event, or symbol.
 - (iii) “Symbol” means any flag, emblem, crest, insignia, representation or other image or indication associated with any group, organization or cause.
3. It shall be the policy of the Town of Montague that the Town:
 - (i) does not make or read proclamations or declarations at Council meetings.
 - (ii) does not erect or display any symbol on Town property.
