**CANDIDATE NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS/GENERAL INFORMATION**

Nomination period commences September 8, 2021 and closes at **2:00 pm September 17, 2021.**

1. Complete Form MGA-RE-3 Nomination of Candidate
  - **Candidates** must be qualified as per the Municipal Government Act (MGA):
    - A person is entitled to run in an election if the person:
      - Is a Canadian citizen;
      - Is at least 18 years of age, or will attain that age on or before election day;
      - The person has been ordinarily resident in the municipality for a period of at least six months before election day.
  - **Nominations** - candidates for Three Rivers, Ward 4 Victoria Cross By-Election must have **five (5)** nominations from qualified electors.
    - A qualified elector:
      - Is a Canadian citizen;
      - Is at least 18 years of age, or will attain that age on or before election day;
      - Has resided in the province for at least the six-month period immediately preceding election day; and
      - Is ordinarily resident in **Three Rivers Ward 4** on election day.

2. Return the completed Nomination form to the election office, Greenfield Stormriders Snowmobile Club, 383 Nielson Road, Montague during the following office hours:
  - Wednesdays 4 pm to 7 pm and Fridays, 10 am to 1 pm starting September 8<sup>th</sup> with additional hours as follows:
  - Nomination day – Friday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, 9 am to 2 pm. **Nominations close at 2:00 pm.**
