6. Correspondence

6.1 Kent Street Video Report

The board asked for more detail from the Kent Street video report. It was confirmed that, due to technical issues, the contractor had not been able to provide the full visual report yet. The board discussed the possible need for further inspections beyond the section covered by the current report.

The board asked about the option of the Town purchasing it's own inspection camera. It was confirmed that staff were looking into this option.

The board asked for an update on their recommendation to Council regarding the extension of services to the Georgetown Business Park, as per the June 21st, 2022 meeting. It was confirmed that Council had accepted the recommendation and that the request had been submitted to Finance PEI, but that there had been no further update at the time of the meeting.

7. New Business

7.1 Funding Sewer Kent Street upgrades - Glenelg Street to Water Street

The board discussed the options for making additional repairs along Main Street, in line with the proposed work to take place as a part of the extension of services to the Georgetown Business Park, including funding options.

The board also considered possible repairs required to other essential sewer infrastructure, including necessary investigations, potential cost estimates and funding options.

The board discussed the long-term benefits of ongoing maintenance and the potential for reduction in pressure on the existing infrastructure if key repairs are made.
