Notes To Applicant

- Applicants are advised to familiarize themselves with the terms of the Street Vendors Bylaw before making an application for a permit.
- The allocation of Preferred Sites is based upon availability and the compatibility of the proposed vending facility with the chosen location. Early applications for these sites are encouraged.
- Applicants seeking a Preferred Site may be offered an alternative location if there is no availability.
- Event Organizers may apply for all vendors participating at their event. They may also advise participating vendors to make individual applications to the Town.
- Vendors who operate food trucks carts etc, will be subject to a 3-day maximum permit period when located within 50 feet of a neighbouring residential building.
- Where a site is proposed on private property the maximum period a permit will last for is 20 days. A
 proposal more than 20 days may require additional consent under the Town of Three Rivers
 Development Bylaw. Please speak to Town staff for further information.
- Vendors operating from private property are individually responsible for obtaining a property owners consent as well as suitable insurance and any other certification(s).
- The Town encourages all vendors to maintain their sites in a clean and presentable condition. Failure to dispose of waste correctly or operations that harmfully impact on neighbouring properties will be subject to fines and/or withdrawal of the permit by the Town.
